

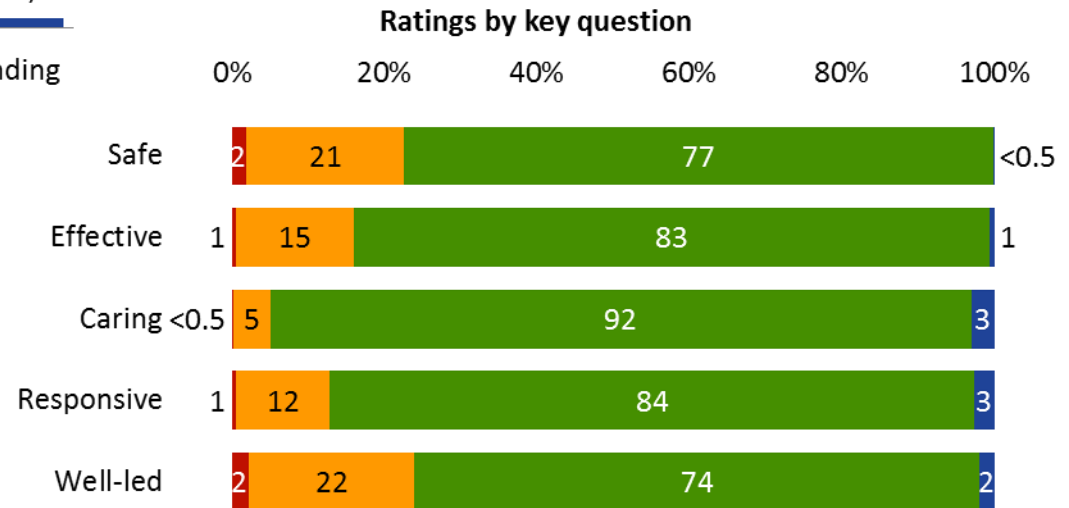
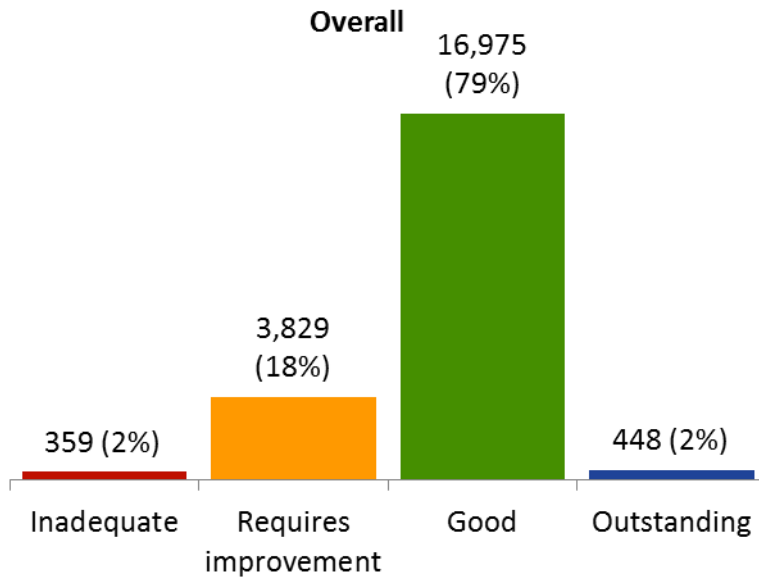

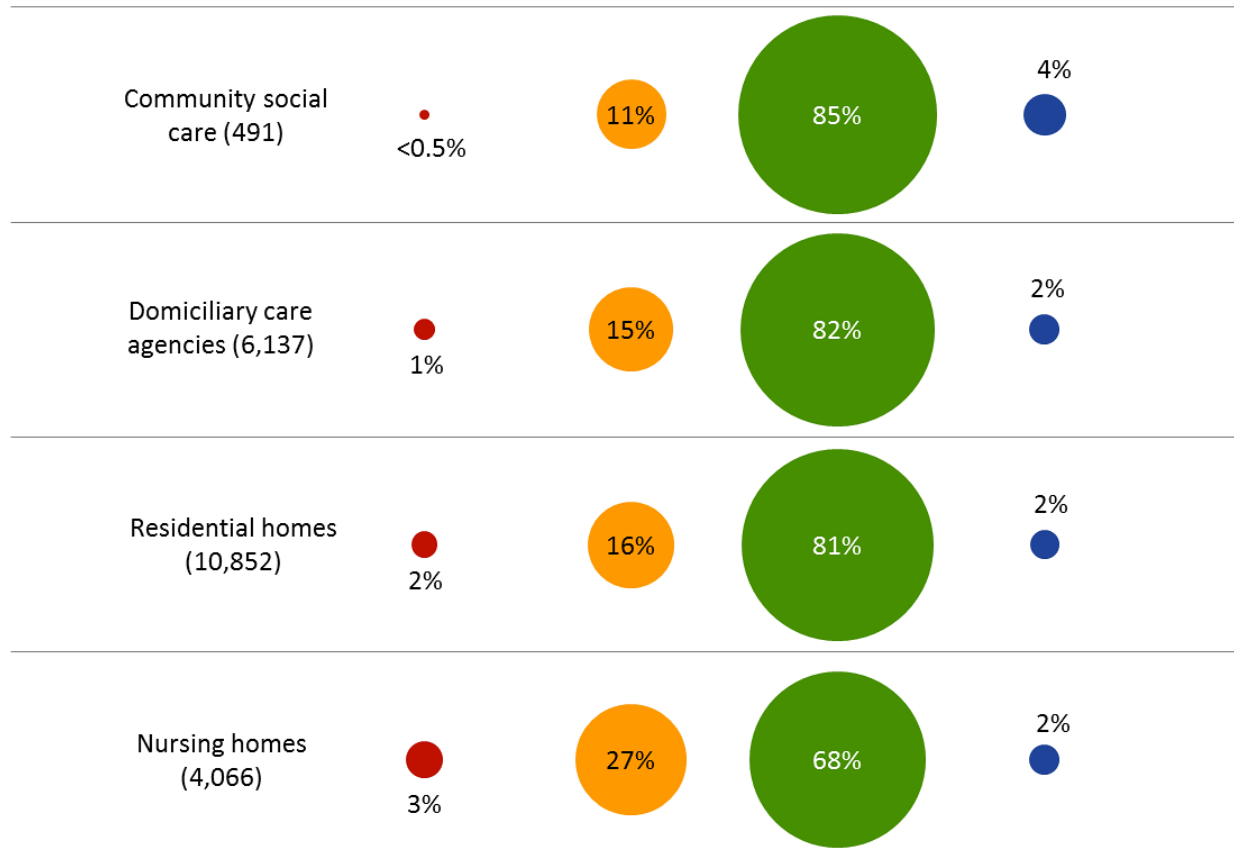

Note: Figures in chart are percentages

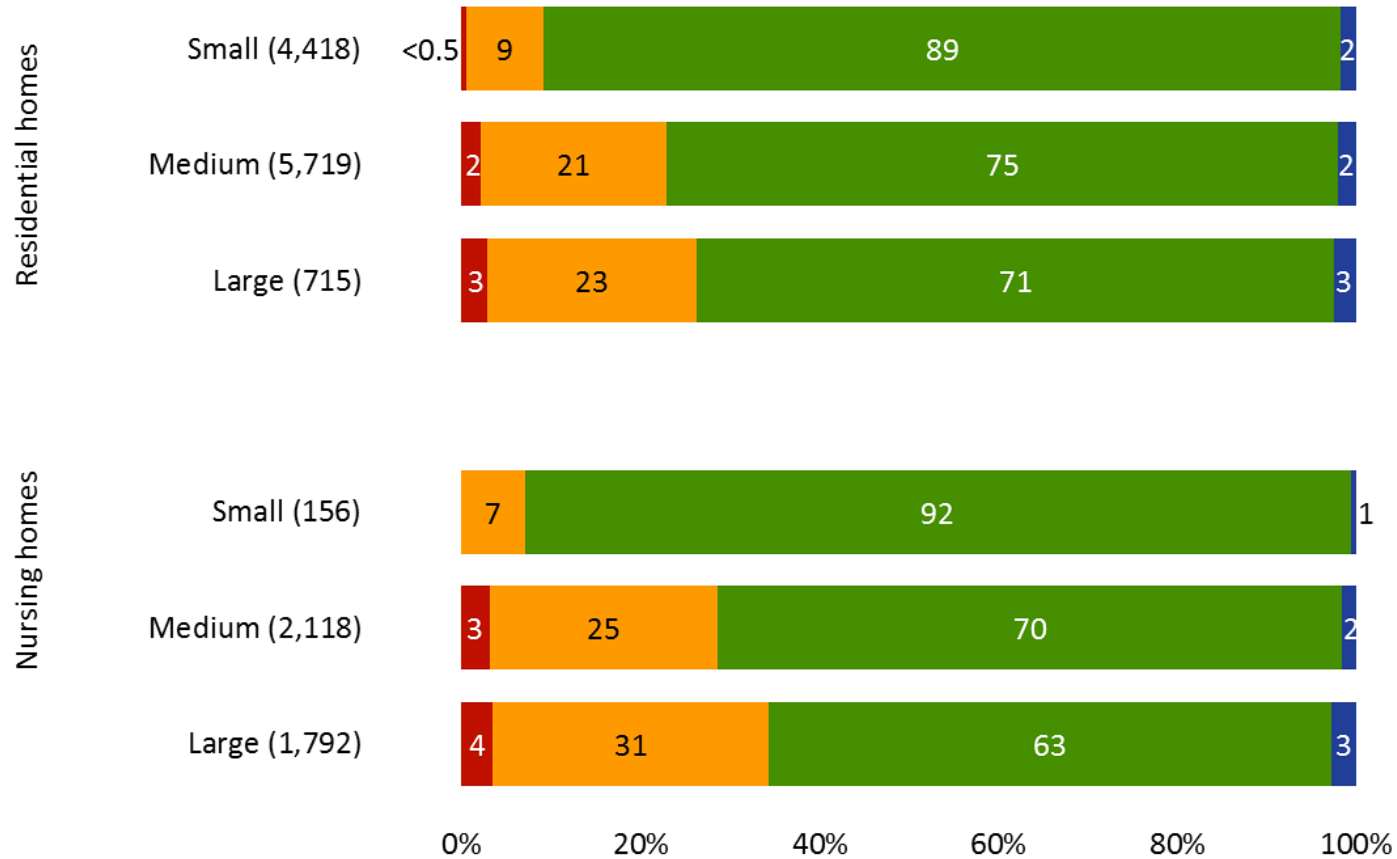
Current overall ratings by service type

Current overall ratings by size of care home

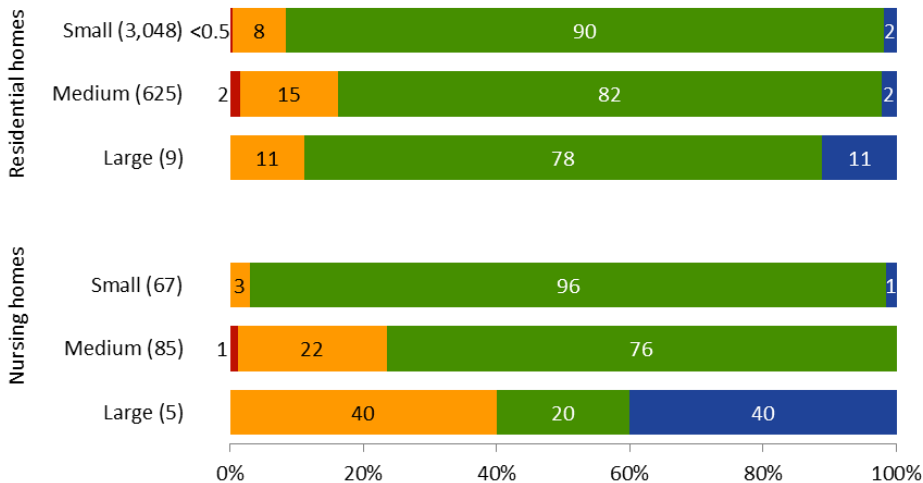


Small = 1-10 beds, Medium = 11-49, Large = 50+

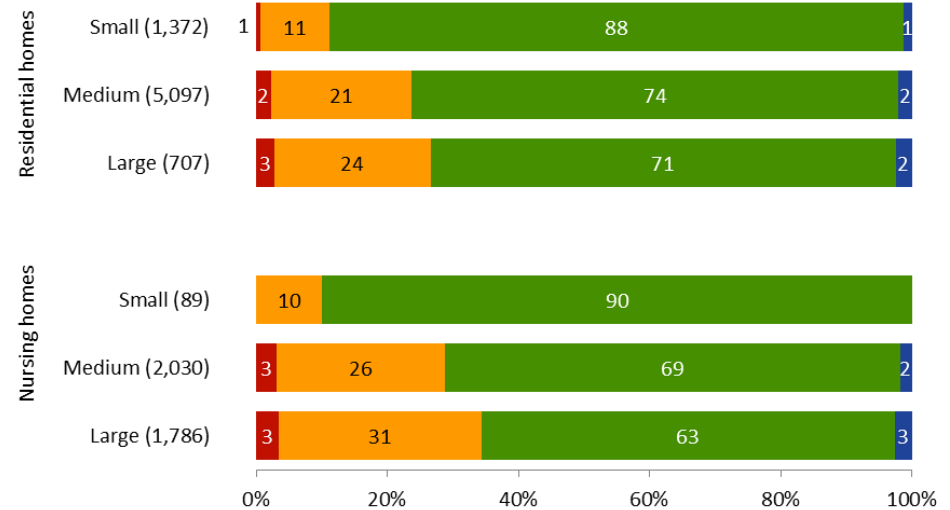
Current overall ratings by size of care home LD and non-LD locations

Current overall ratings by size of domiciliary care agency

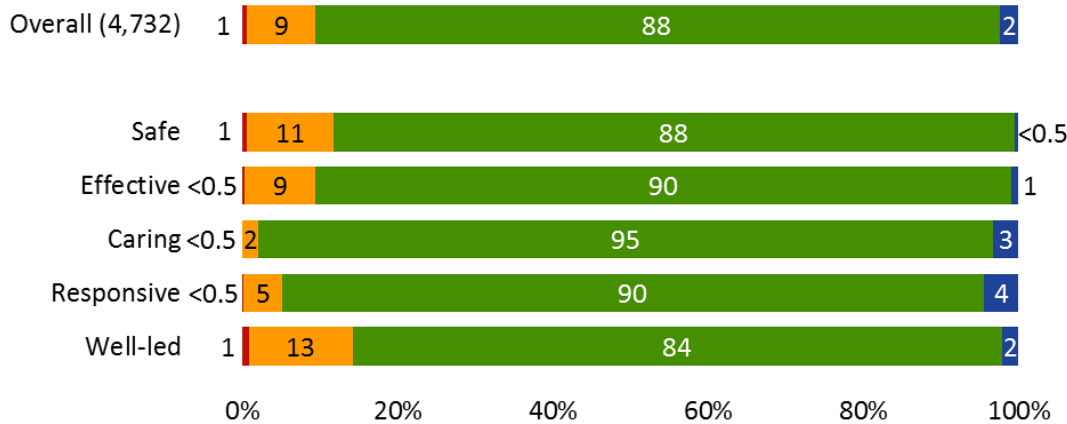

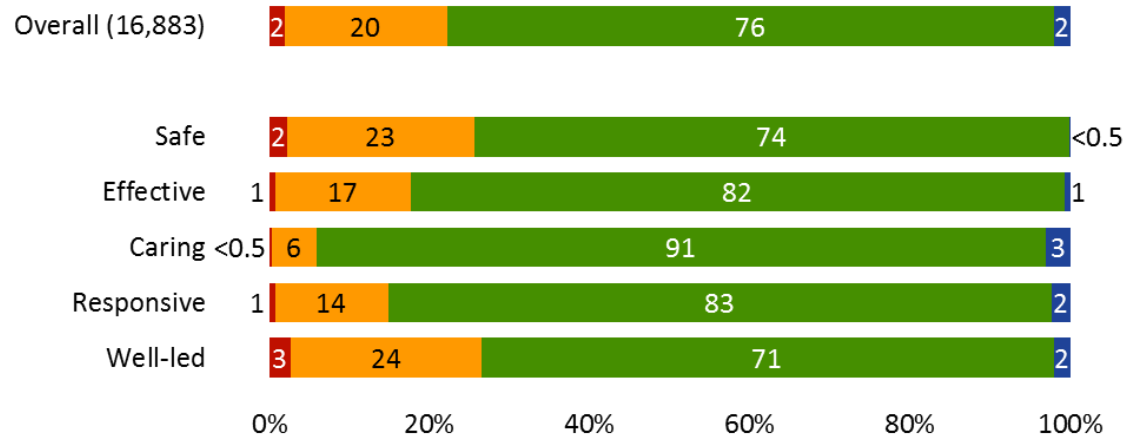
Current overall ratings for services with and without learning disability specialism



ASC locations with learning disability specialism



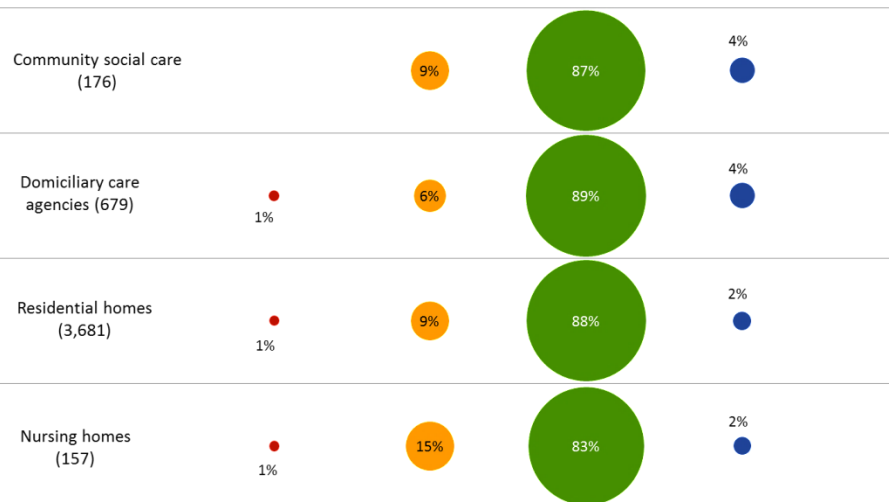
ASC locations without learning disability specialism



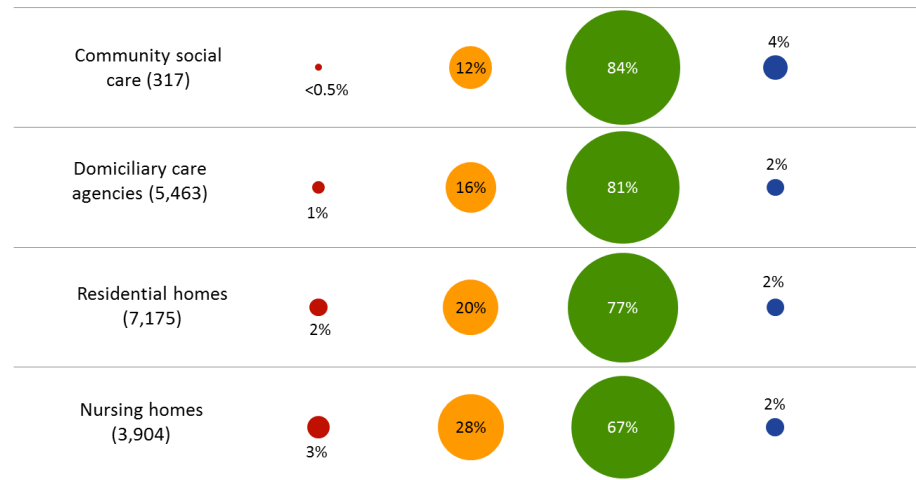
Current overall ratings by type of services with and without learning disability specialism



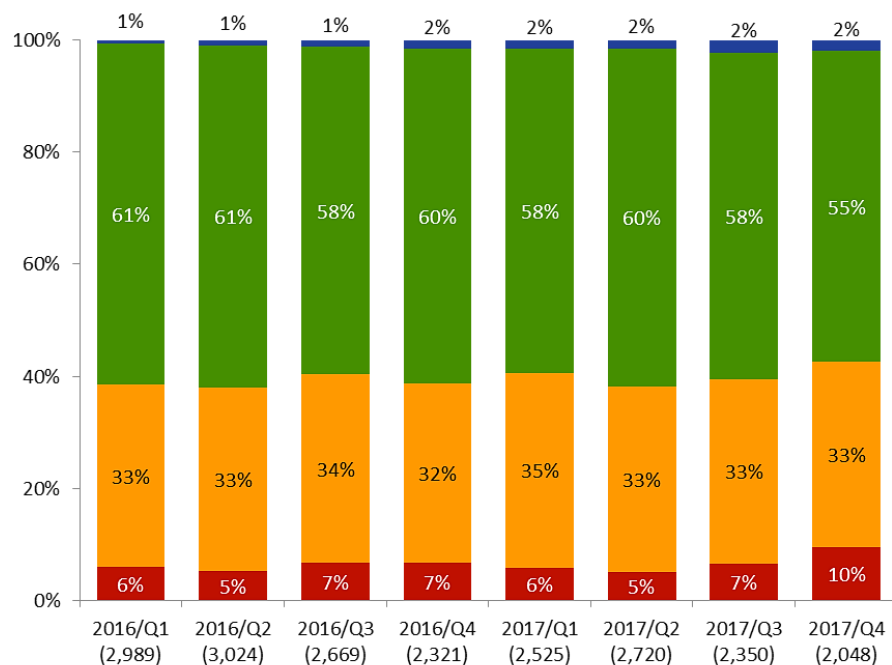
Services with learning disability specialism



Services without learning disability specialism

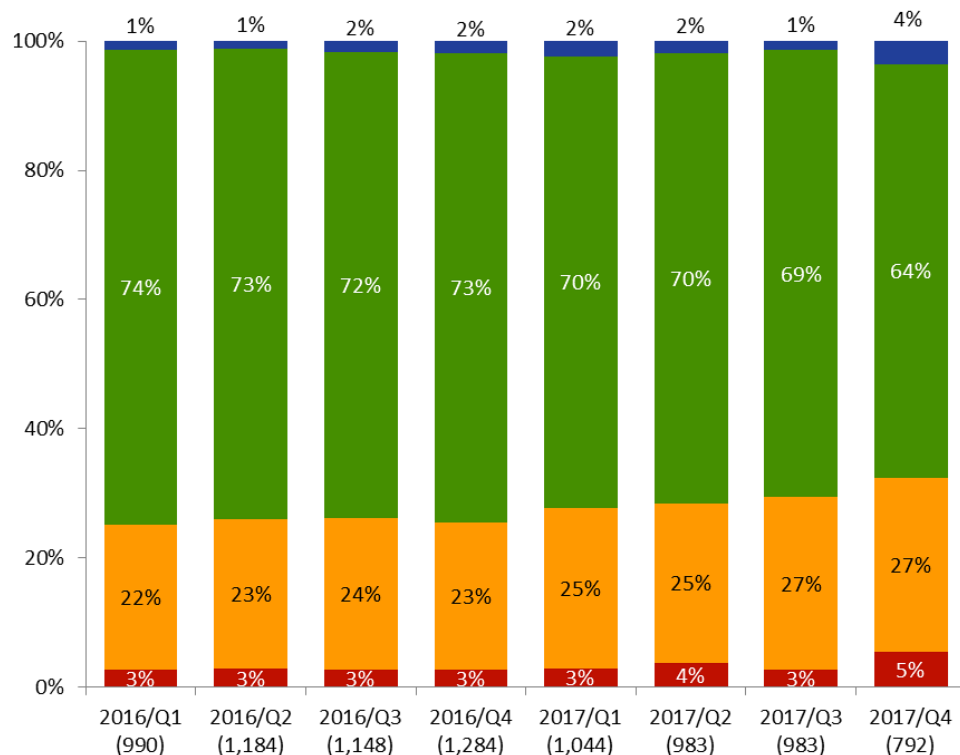

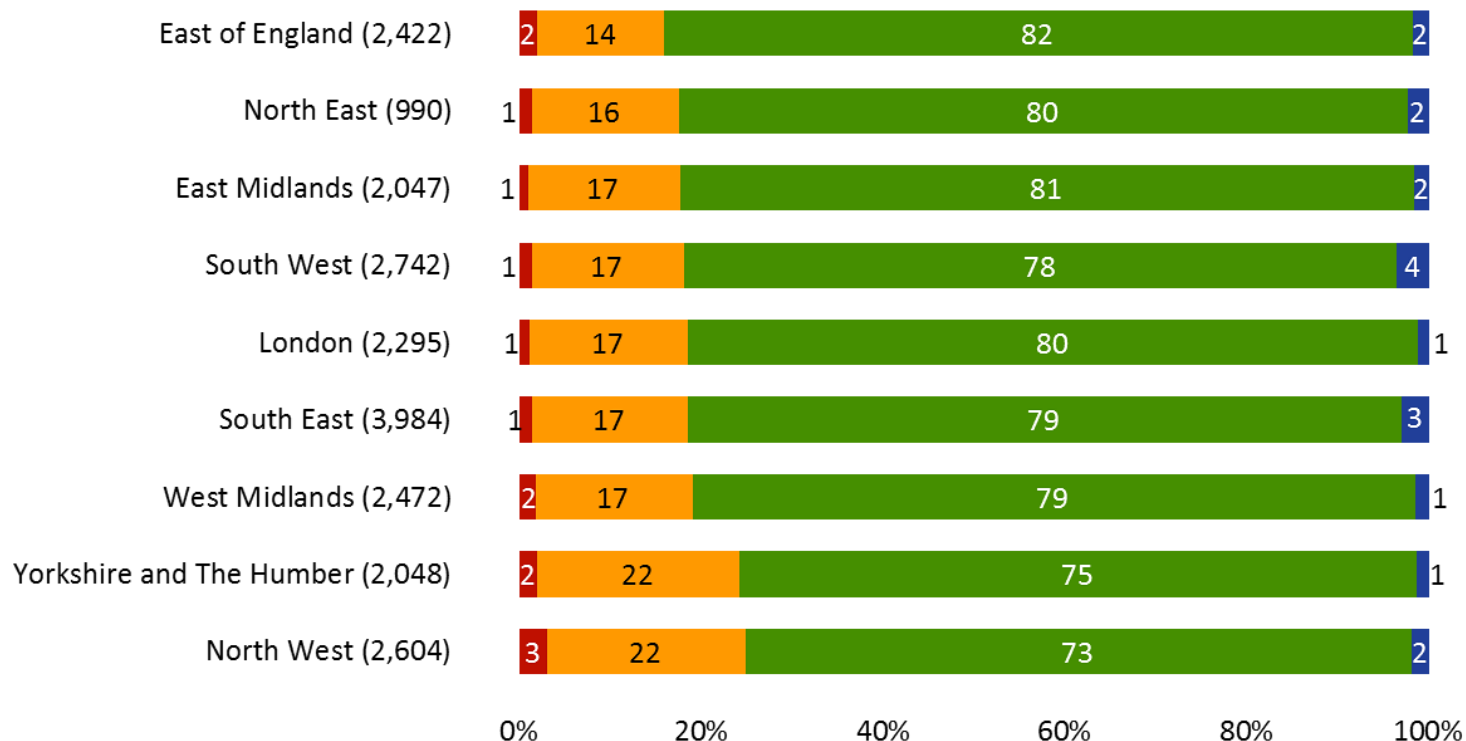

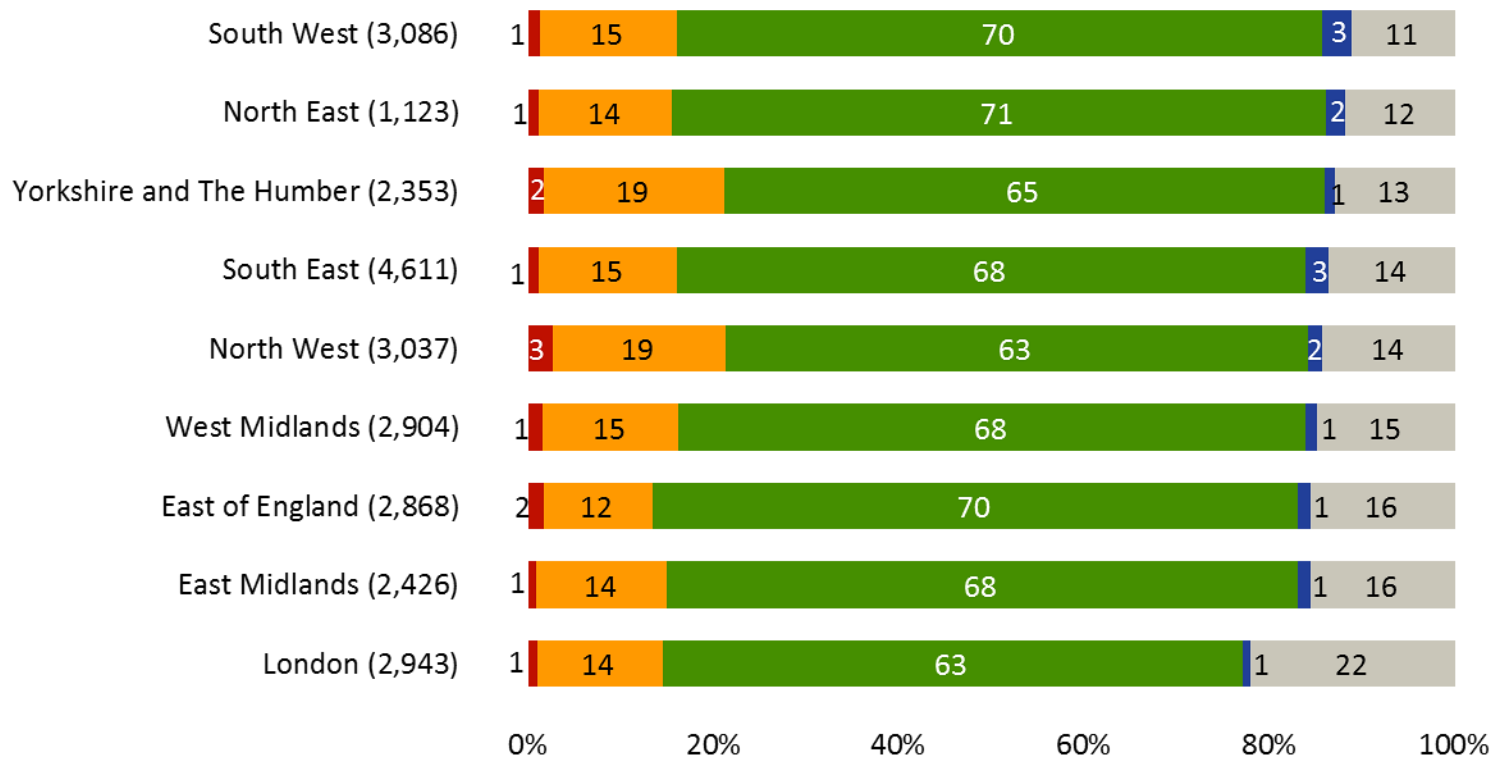

Overall ratings by region (all locations)

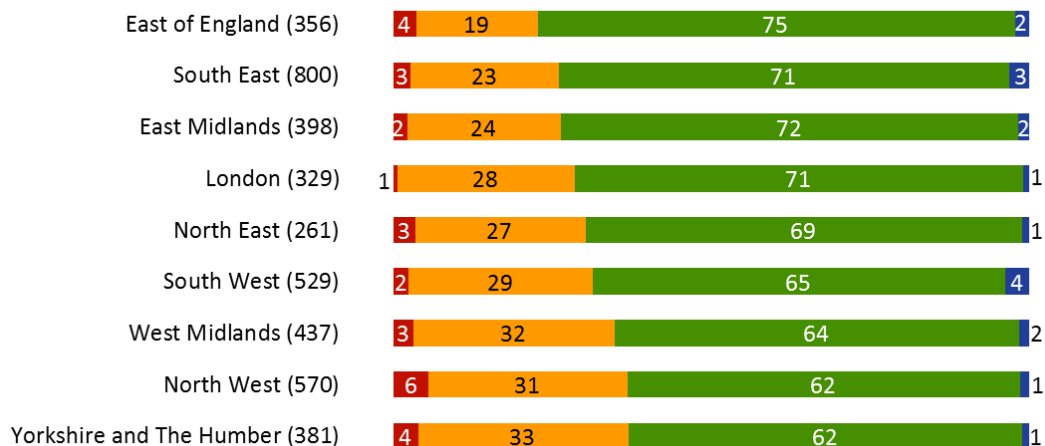

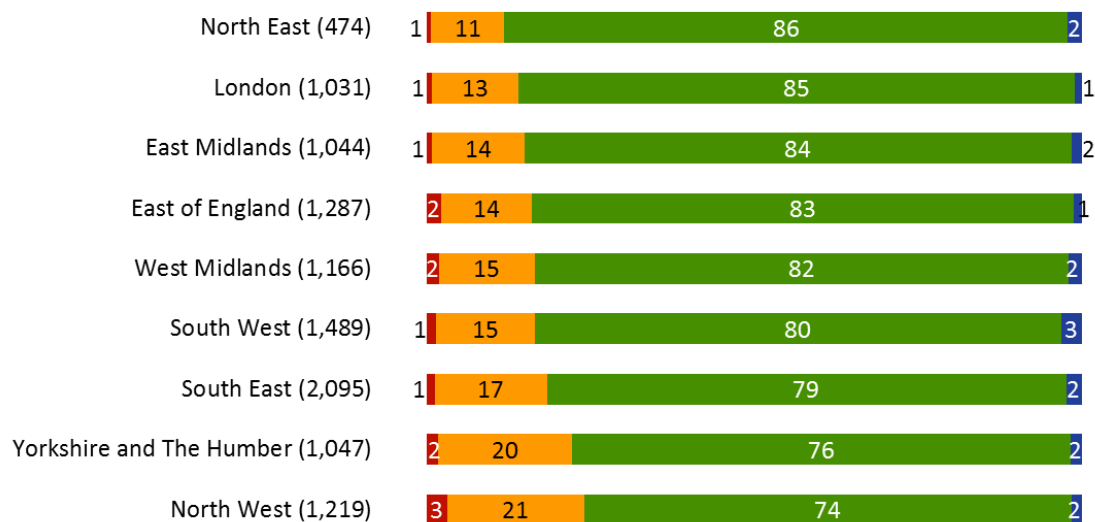
Nursing and Residential ratings by region
