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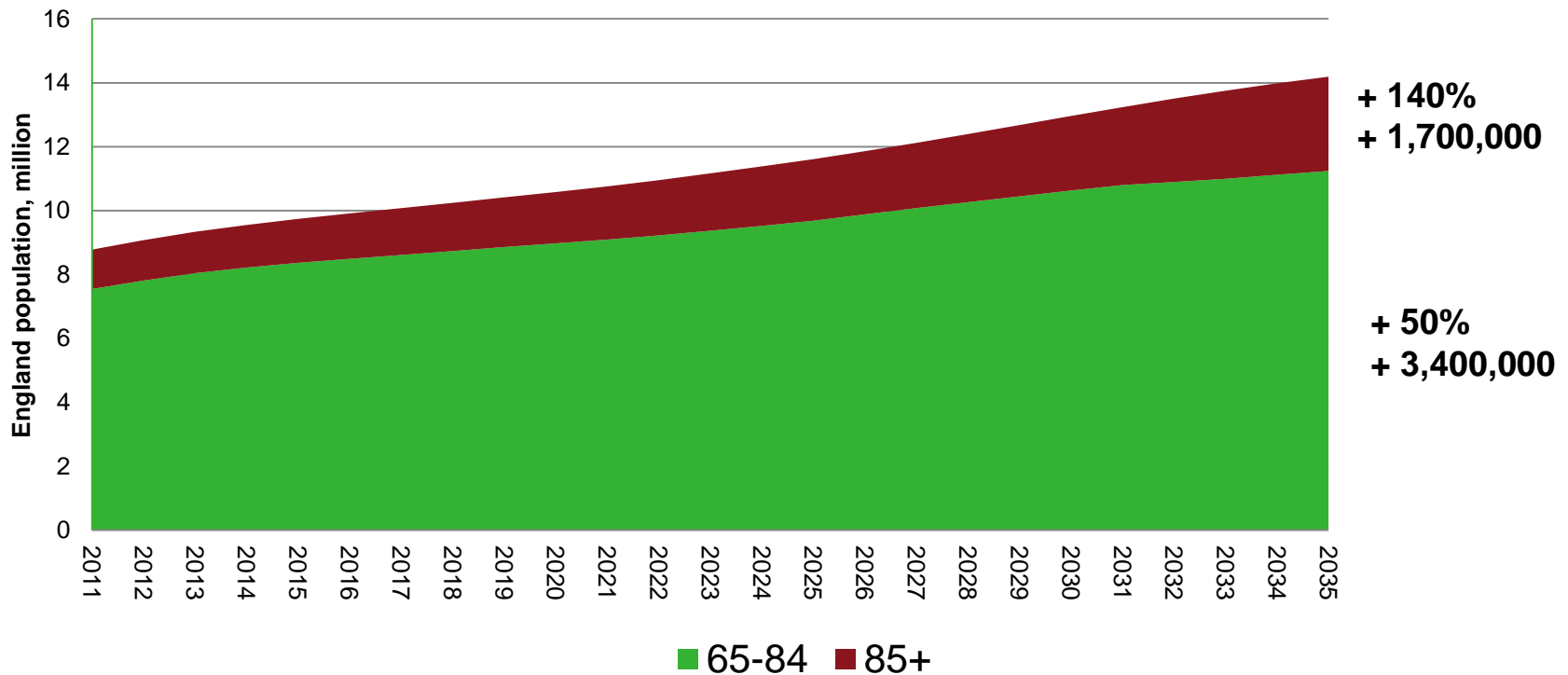

The number of people aged 85+ will more than double in the next 20 years.

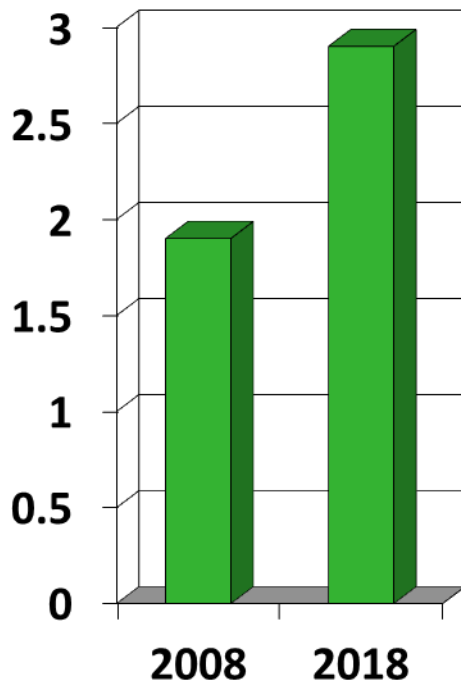
Projected population aged 65+

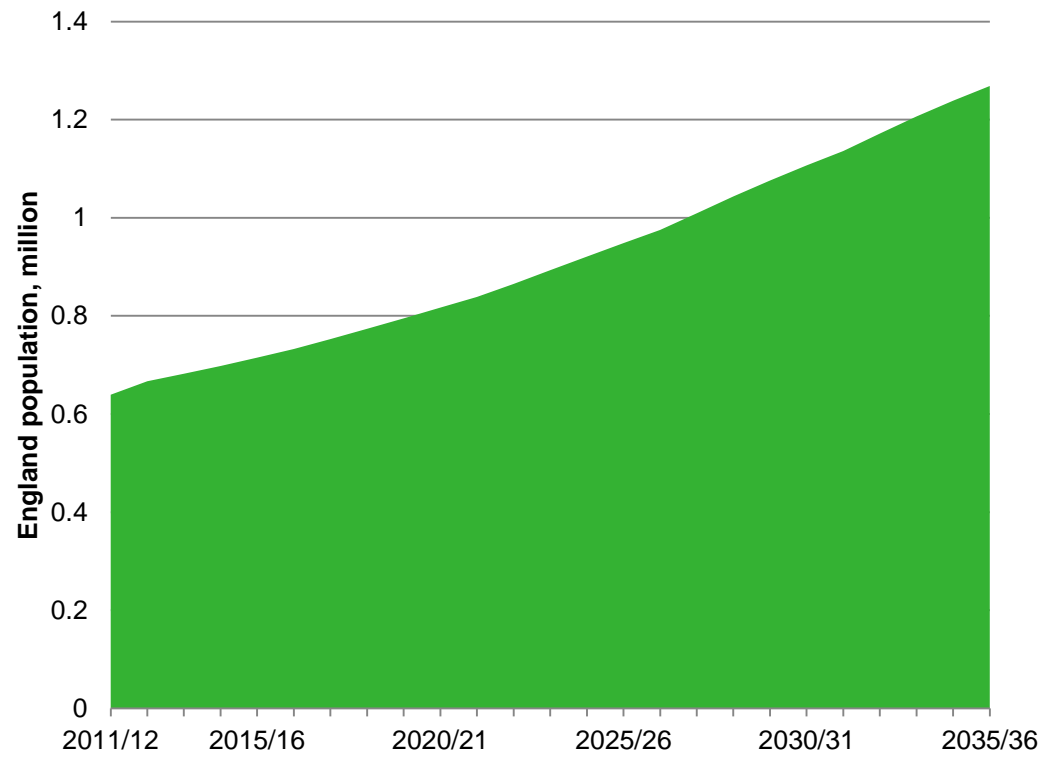
...and have greater needs.

Projected Dementia Prevalence

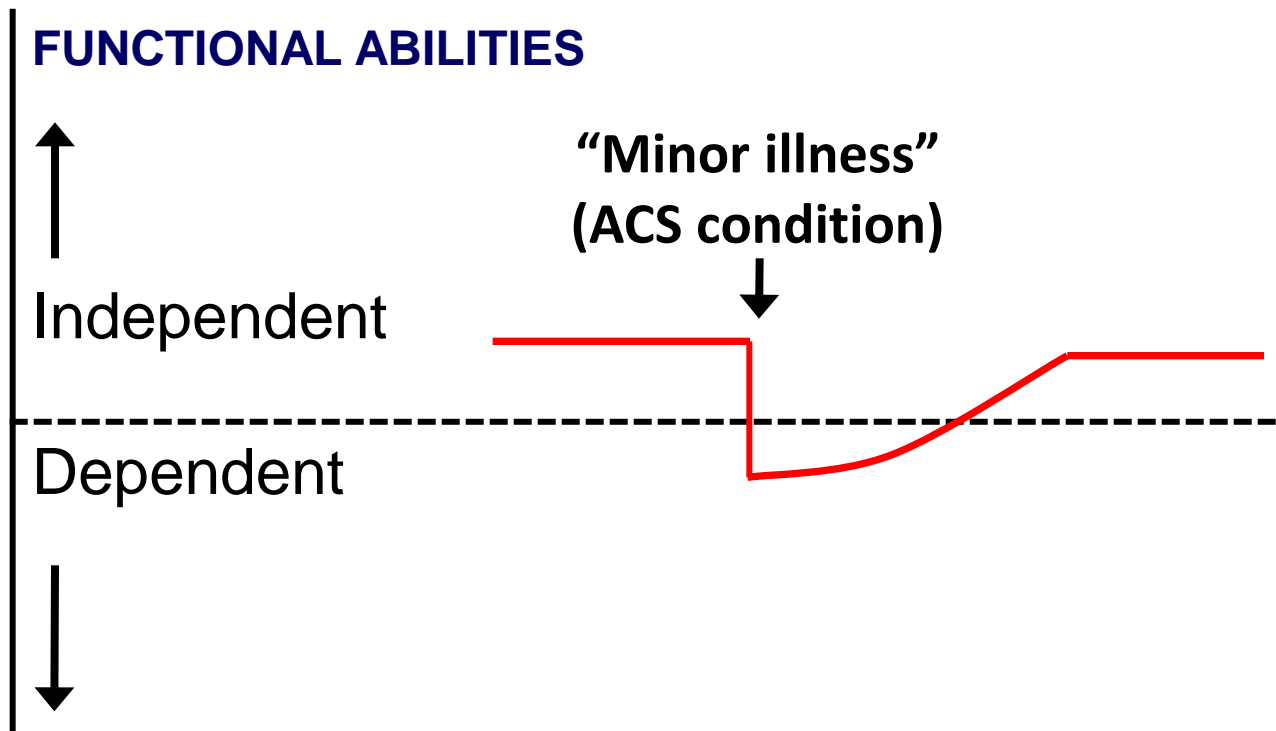

Context

Frailty as the construct for integration

- Most problematic expression of population ageing
- Cumulative decline in multiple physiological systems (muscles, brain, immunity)
- Affects 25% of >85yr olds

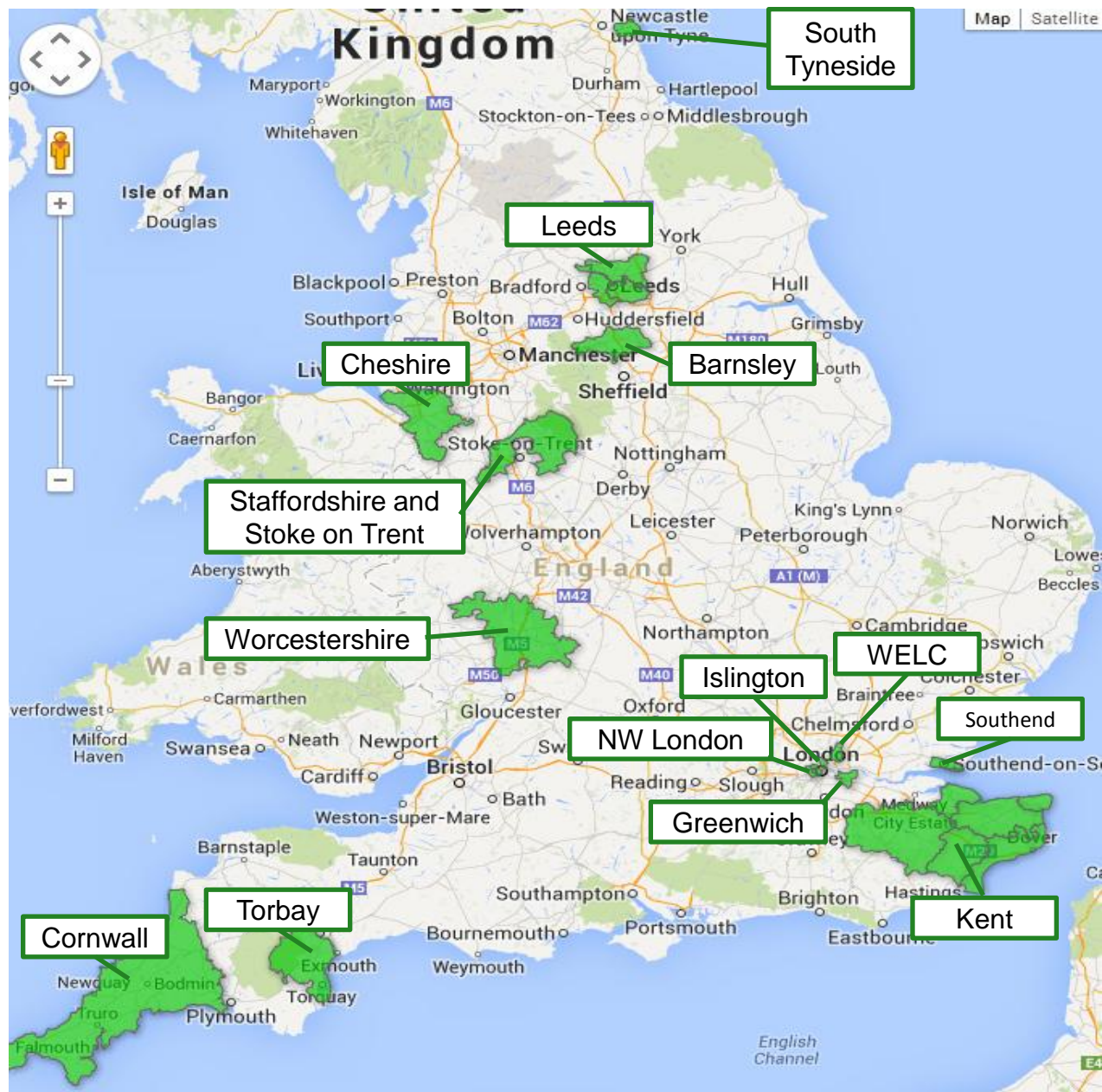
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14 Pioneer Sites

- Announced on 1 November 2013

- Range of client groups – not only the elderly



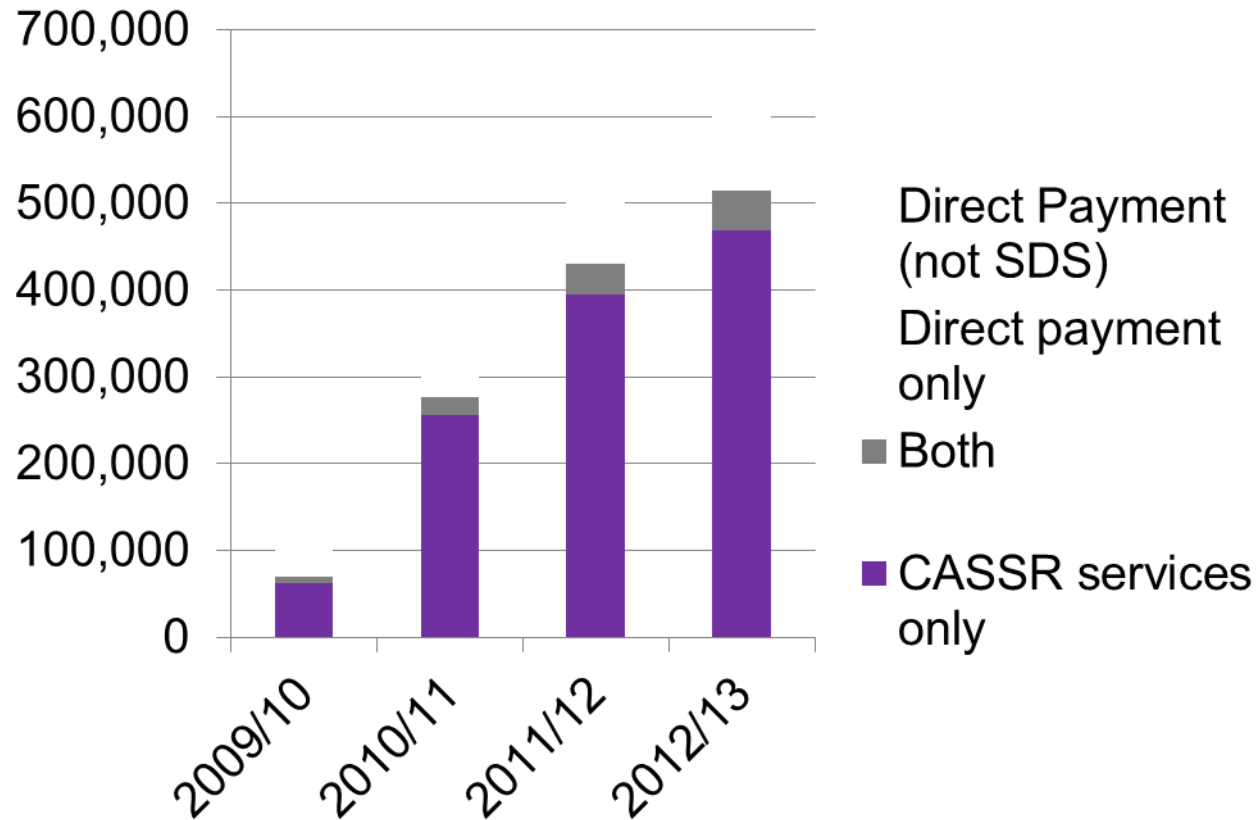


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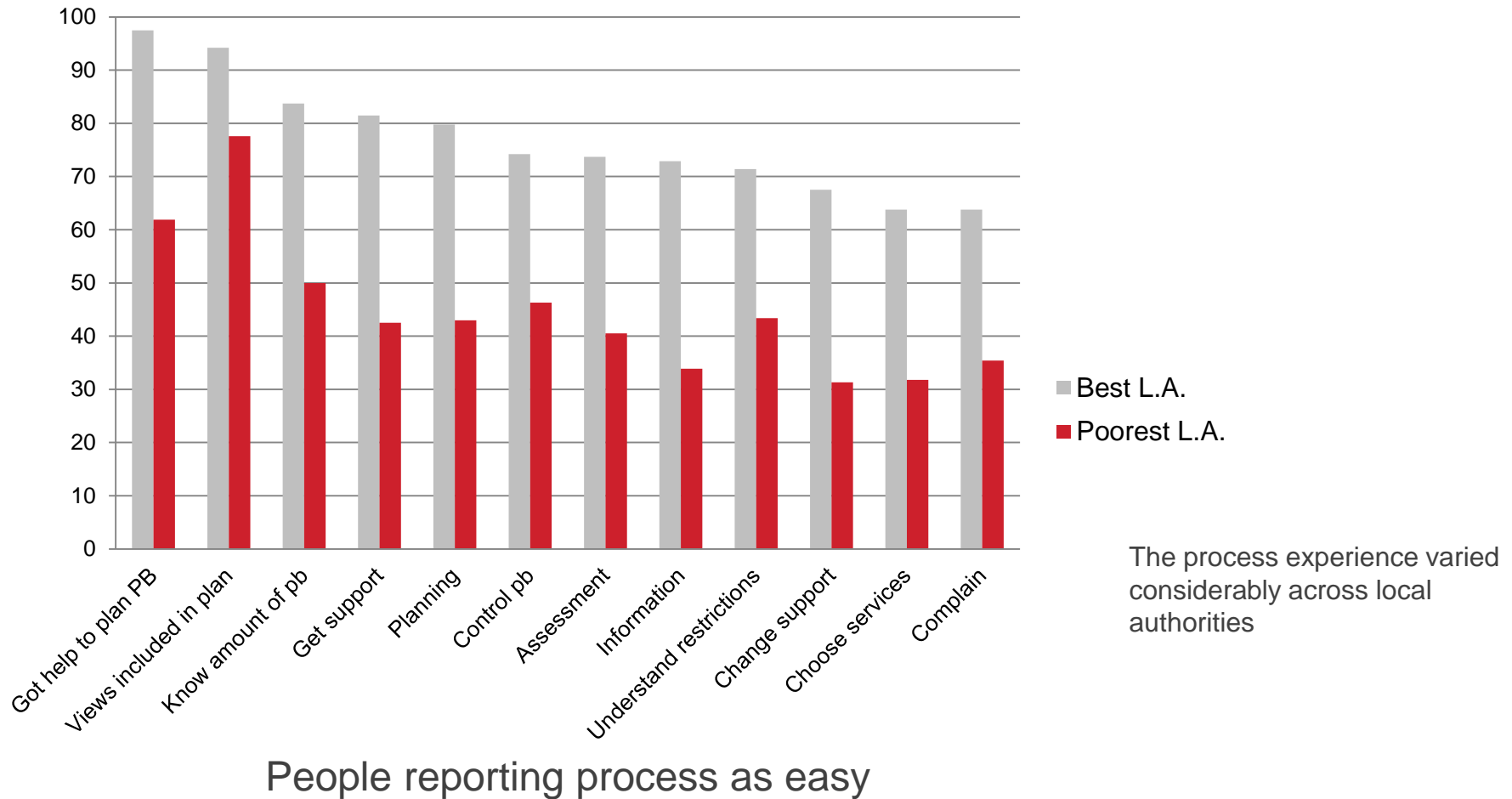
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The uptake of personal budgets in England (HSCIC)

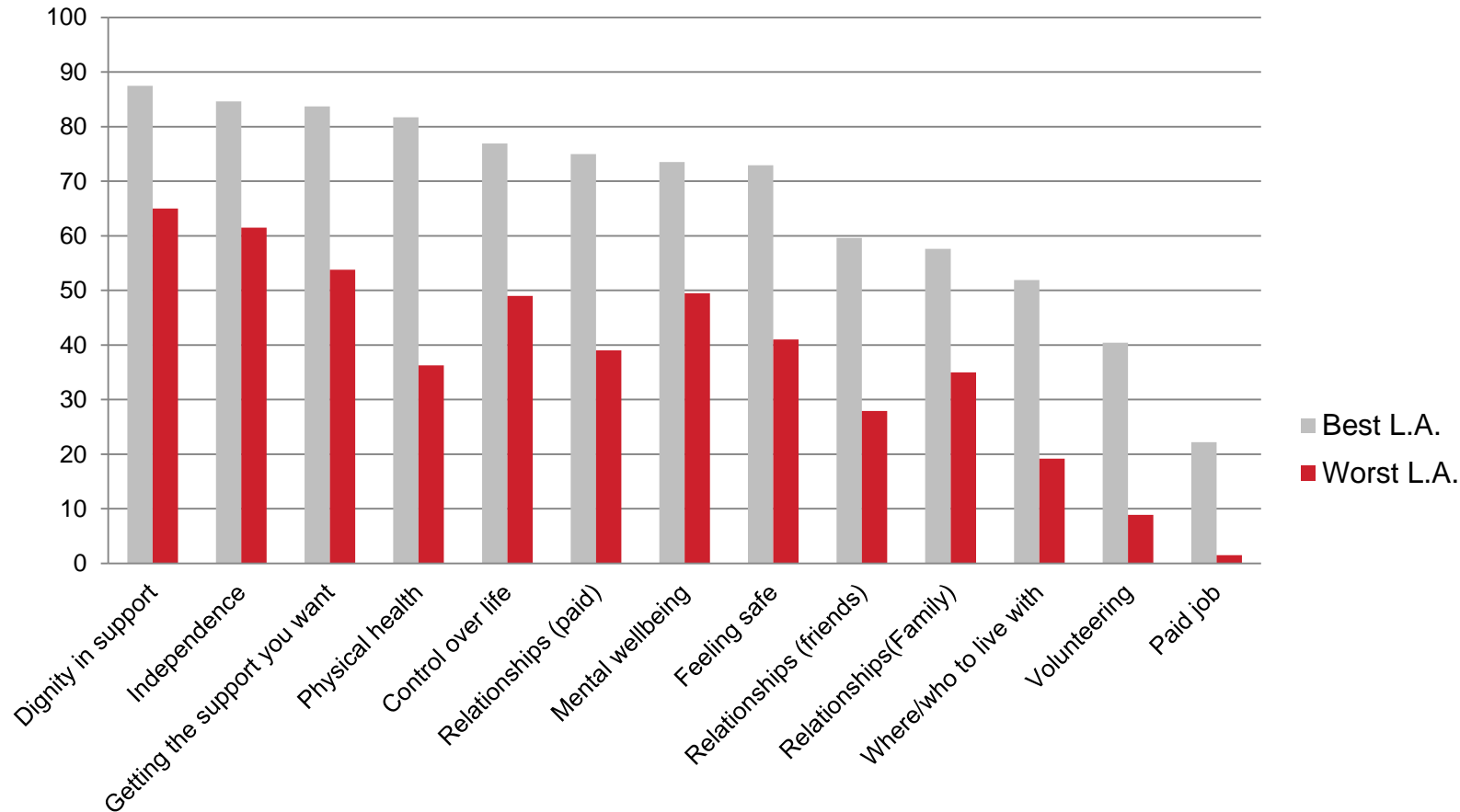


- Very large increase in number of people recorded as using self-directed support
- Large majority of SDS and biggest increases over time in council-managed SDS
- Much more limited increase in people using direct payments
